

# Prof. Yung-Sheng Liu Global Talents Scholarship

Revised and passed by IPT Faculty Meeting on May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017

## 1. Purpose

To honor Prof. Yung-Sheng Liu's remarkable contribution to IPT and support international young talents in the field of photonics, IPT hereby establishes this scholarship under the name of Prof. Yung-Sheng Liu.

## 2. Funding Sources

- (1) Donation fund: Prof. Yung-Sheng Liu's initial 100K NT donation to IPT and follow-up donations to IPT. The maximum allocated fund is 250k NT per year, subject to adjustment in IPT meeting whenever necessary. This part of fund will support
  - a. incoming foreign students, including Mainland students and postdocs,
  - b. outgoing NTHU-registered undergraduate students just admitted by IPT
  - c. outgoing undergraduate project-course students supervised or ever supervised by an IPT faculty member.
- (2) IPT student assistantship fund: The maximum allocated fund is 250 k NT per year, subject to adjustment in IPT meeting whenever necessary. The part of fund will support outgoing registered IPT students.

## 3. Eligibility

- (1) Taiwan Students: following listed students who propose an outgoing research visit exceeding 2 months.
  - a. A registered IPT student supervised by an IPT faculty member.
  - b. A registered NTHU undergraduate student who has been admitted to IPT and designated an IPT faculty member as his/her supervisor.
  - c. A registered NTHU undergraduate student who is taking or has taken a project-study course from an IPT faculty member.
- (2) Foreign Students: any incoming student or postdoctoral researcher from a foreign university or research institute, who proposes to conduct a research visit to NTHU for more than 2 months and is supervised by an IPT faculty member.

## 4. Amount of scholarship

- (1) Maximum of 30k NT cash award to each approved Taiwan student.
- (2) Maximum of 30k NT to defray the flight ticket (economic class) and/or NTHU dormitory fee for each approved foreign student.

## 5. Application Materials

- (1) Curriculum Vitae
- (2) Certificate of school registration (student) or employment (postdoc).

- (3) Term transcripts
- (4) A reference letter provided by an IPT faculty member.
- (5) Research project for the visit
6. Selection process
  - (1) Application based on first-come first serve, until the annual quota of fund is shorter than 30k NT.
  - (2) An applicant has to submit all the application materials to IPT at least one month prior to the departure of the proposed research visit.
  - (3) The IPT director appoints at least three faculty members to form a review committee to vote and approve an applicant.
7. Obligations

The awardee's supervisor, an IPT faculty member, has the mandate to request and sign a report from the awardee within one month upon completion of the research visit.

  - (1) The report will be posted to the IPT website.
  - (2) The report will become a reference material for the review committee to consider subsequent applications recommended by the IPT faculty member.
  - (3) If an awardee fails to submit the report by the 1-month deadline, IPT does not accept subsequent applications recommended by the awardee's supervisor for 3 years.
8. Validity of this scholarship program is subject to the availability of at least 30k NT left in the donation fund.
9. The content and revision of this scholarship are subject to the approval of the IPT faculty meeting.
10. In case of any discrepancy between the English version and the Chinese version of this program, the Chinese version shall prevail
